EDUCATION COMMITTEE

Presentation: Student Leadership Forum Review

Student Trustee White introduced student Hanna Gould and Jett Larsen who provided an overview of the Student Leadership Survey at Princeton Secondary School. The students reviewed a list of items that are working well and items that need improvement.

Priority Measures Update

The Superintendent noted that consultation occurred at both the district and school level and that 7 schools were identified to have areas of need. He advised that at present, 6.10 FTE annualized to 3.1 has been allocated.

Reporting Student Progress Committee

The Superintendent informed that a District Reporting Student Progress Committee has been struck consisting of students, parents, teachers, principals and trustees. The purpose of the Committee is to gather and synthesize stakeholder input and set direction for the 2017/2018 reporting at the K-9 level, with the first meeting to take place in April.

OPERATIONS COMMITTEE

After School Program / Proposed Late Bus

The Superintendent advised of ASSAI (After School Sports and Arts Initiative) contacting the district with a grant to fund an afterschool program for students that may not be able to participate due to socioeconomic reasons. He noted that approximately twenty to twenty-five thousand dollars has been committed for a two to three-year period. He noted that to facilitate this, a late bus run on Tuesday's and Thursday's will be piloted to help students be able to participate.

Nicola Lake School Sale

It was discussed, as per prior meetings, that the Board intends to sell the Nicola-Lake School land and buildings, subject to Ministerial approval.
